

## Conference Site

### Directions to City Hall:

#### From North Central Expressway

Follow the signs to I-30 West. Exit at Ervay Street. Turn right on Ervay and drive three blocks to Canton. Turn left. City Hall will be on your right. Proceed to Akard and turn right. Entry to the parking lot will be on your right.

#### From East Dallas, heading west on I-30

Take the Ervay exit (from the left lane) and turn right at the second light on Ervay. Proceed as above to the parking area.

#### From Oak Cliff, heading east on I-30

As I-30 merges with traffic from I-35, take the access road of I-30, marked Lamar and Griffin, to the Cadiz exit (second exit). Go right on Cadiz and turn left on Akard.

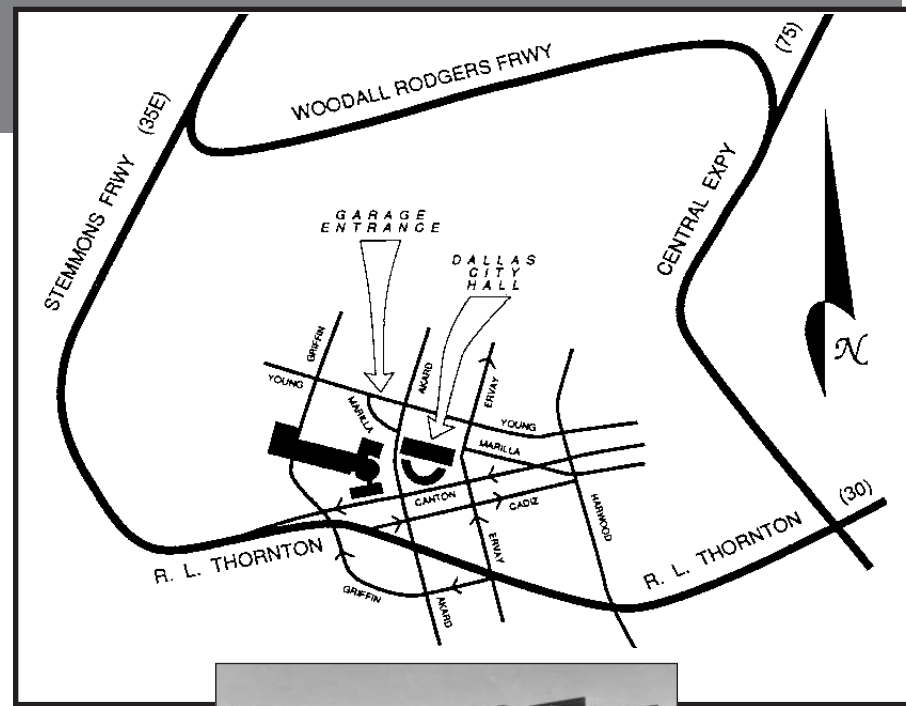
#### From Northwest Dallas, heading south on I-35 (Stemmons)

Take the exit for eastbound I-30, but stay in the second lane from the left. Exit onto the access road, marked "Lamar and Griffin," to the Cadiz exit (second exit). Go right on Cadiz and turn left on Akard.

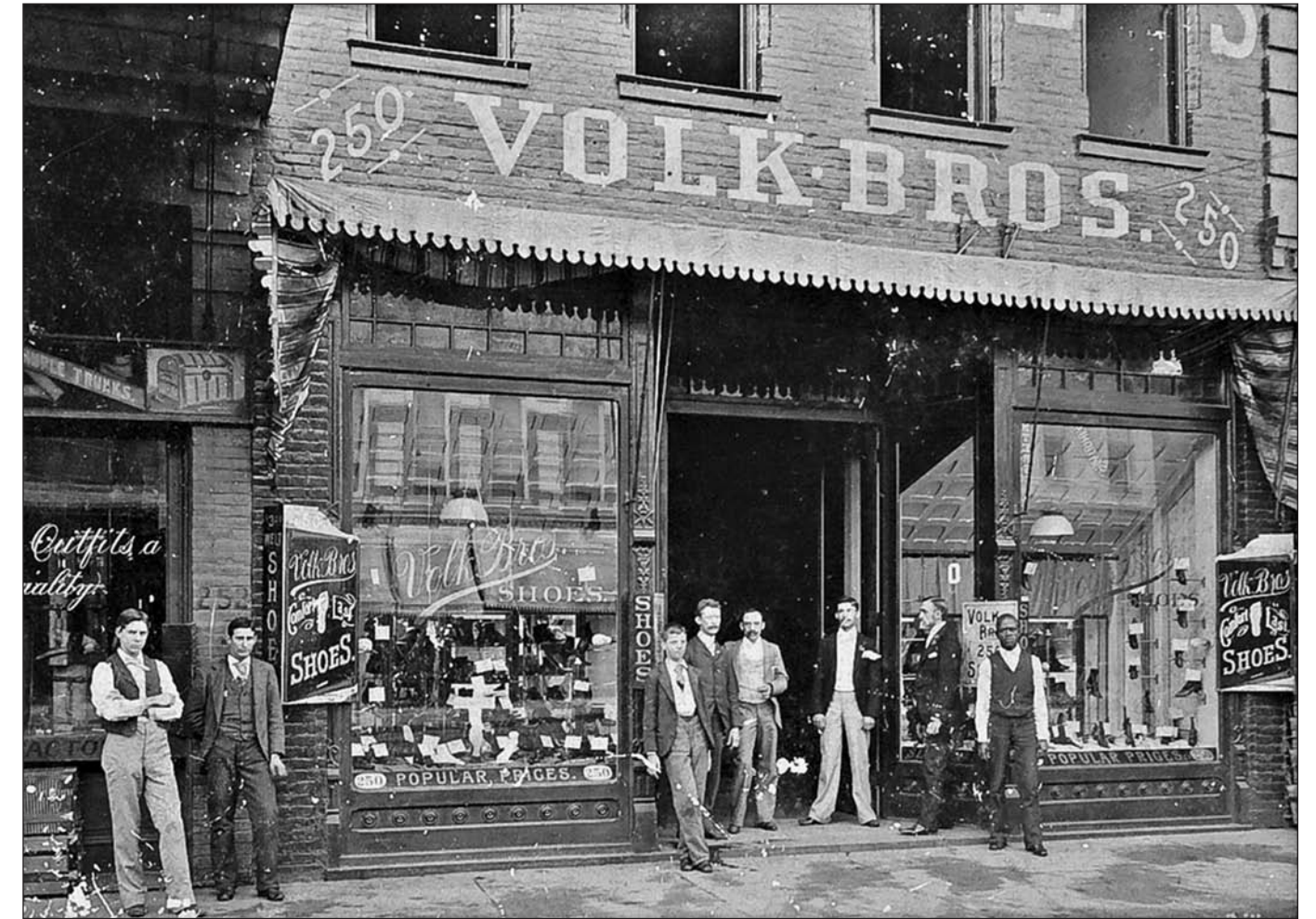

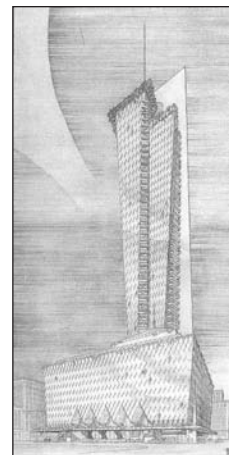
